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Pursuant to the Government Accountability Office (GAO) rules on the public availability of records, 4 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 81, and the attached letter of request, this is to respectfully request electronic versions of the redacted materials filed in the referenced pending bid protest. I am a professor of government procurement law at the George Washington University Law School, and as is discussed below I request these records so that information and analysis regarding the subject procurement – a multi-billion dollar procurement to open commercial electronic marketplaces to federal users – can be made available to the public. If these records are not released, key information on this major procurement will be blocked from the public for roughly three months – the 100-day period for a GAO bid protest to be decided.
